### GROWER'S COMMENTS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

#### DUSTY MILLER

In general, this is a very easy annual to grow as long as the soil is kept moist to dry and the yellow flowers are removed to promote good leaf growth. Pruning periodically will also help to maintain a low bushy shape. This annual is generally resistant to insects and disease and will tolerate hot, dry weather as well as frost. In general, this dusty, silver annual will grow 8 to 10 inches tall and would benefit from a general purpose fertilizer once a month. Since it has an excellent frost tolerance it is not surprising that it will reappear in the spring if the winter has not been too harsh. By planting in the full sun this annual adds both a color and a texture contrast in the garden or container that is very unique..
